WIND SPEED RECORD LOG

Please note: Along with the equipment you have hired, we have left an anemometer. This is to ensure that the inflatable is not used in high winds, which are defined as gusts of 24mph or more. This is for the safety of everyone at your event.

Upon signing your hire agreement and this wind record sheet, you confirm that you agree that it is your responsibility to check and record the wind speed every half an hour during the hire period.

If you have had to turn the inflatable off due to windspeeds, it must not be turned back on until you have 30 minutes of consecutive readings of 20mph or lower. (During this time readings should be taken every 5 minutes.) This is for the safety of you and your guests.

If the anemometer stops working or you have any concerns about the weather wind speeds, please do get in touch with us, the hire company immediately.

DISCLAIMER

I understand that it is my responsibility as the hirer to measure and record the wind speeds every 30 minutes during the duration of the hire period. I agree that if the wind speed shows 24mph or over, I will evacuate the inflatable and turn it off as instructed, immediately.
